The Churchill Area Neighbors is your community Neighborhood Association.

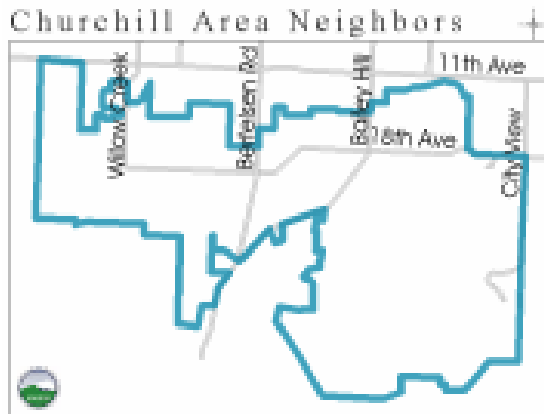
We represent a direct link between you, the diverse citizens of the Churchill Area, and the City of Eugene.
